

Update to Your 2023 Medicare Part B Prescription Drug Costs

February, 2023

This is important information about what you will pay for your Medicare Part B prescription drugs. These are separate from the medications covered under your SCAN Part D prescription drug benefit. These changes were released by Medicare after your 2023 plan materials were produced and could result in lower costs to you.

Please see the chart below for the information that applies to your plan.

Effective April 1, 2023, you may pay a coinsurance <i>lower than 20%</i> of the Medicare-approved amount for select Part B Drugs.	Contact our Member Services if you have questions about what you will pay for Medicare Part B Prescription Drugs.
Effective July 1, 2023, you won't pay more than \$35 for a one-month supply of a Part B insulin furnished with a durable medical equipment, such as a medically necessary insulin pump.	We also cover insulins listed in the 2023 SCAN Formulary (Drug list) under our Part D prescription drug benefit. These changes do not apply to Part D insulins. For SCAN Embrace (HMO SNP):

Effective April 1, 2023, you may pay a coinsurance lower than 20% of the Medicare-approved amount for select Part B Drugs. You will continue paying \$0 copayment for select nebulized medications. Effective July 1, 2023, you won't pay more than \$35 for a one-month supply of a Part B insulin furnished with a durable medical equipment, such as a medically necessary insulin pump.	We also cover insulins listed in the 2023 SCAN Formulary (Drug list) under our Part D prescription drug benefit. These changes do not apply to Part D insulins.
