Material available in threshold languages	Proof of ability to provide this material such as listing of available vendor/agency to utilize when needed. This can be listed in P&P.	
Material available in alternative format	Proof of ability to provide this material such as listing of available vendor/agency to utilize when needed. This can be listed in P&P.	
Availability of translation services	Demonstrate awareness of health plan or other services. Group may show procedure sheet for accessing services.	
Risk-reduction educational intervention for tobacco use and cessation	Pamphlet, flyer, class description or class schedule: Separate for of the eight requirements
